"Hello everyone! My name is Ethan, and I am proud to be both a Swim Teacher and Lifeguard at Littlehampton Wave, the very place where my own swimming journey began at just four months old!

Growing up beside the beautiful Sussex coast, my parents were adamant that swimming was a non-negotiable life skill for my brother, sister, and me. We all started in the Parent and Baby sessions at the original Littlehampton Swimming Centre, and none of us were allowed to stop lessons until we had completed

the full programme (which finished at Improver 3 back then). After that, we could choose our own path: join the Littlehampton Swimming Club or become a Little Lifeguard. I chose the Swimming Club, and I am so glad I did.

At Georgian Gardens Primary School, my Year 6 teacher, Ben (who represented GB as a reserve goalkeeper at the 2012 Olympics), encouraged me to join an inter-school water polo team. Mum didn't even know what water polo was at the time, but fast forward nine years, and I am now incredibly proud to be part of the Great Britain U20 Men's Squad, as well as the Worthing Senior Men's Team, where I now train and compete alongside him.

Swimming has opened so many doors for me, and I truly believe that introducing children to the water in their preschool years is the key to a lifelong love of swimming. Every day at The Wave, I get to see the joy, confidence, and laughter of our youngest swimmers, many of whom don't even realise they're in a lesson because they're having so much fun.
