Once registered, accessing the home portal allows you to:

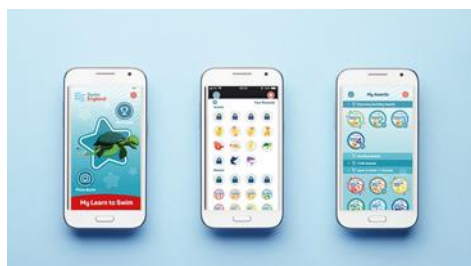
- View the outcomes for each stage of the Swim England Framework

**Swim hats:** We are reintroducing swim hats to the programme, your child will be issued with their first swim hats, free-of-charge, by their swimming teacher, just like judo belts, the colour of the hat relates to the stage your child has reached. Working towards and achieving their next hat can become a real motivator for children and we will be making sure that every time a child earns their next hat that this is celebrated, as mentioned above. As well as the motivation of working through the hat colours, having each stage wear different colour hats is also a way of lifeguards and teachers instantly identifying that each child is safely in the right section of the pool, helping us keep your child safe. Finally, hats are a brilliant way of us keeping the pool water crystal clear for our swimmers, as well as keeping the hair safely away from children's faces. Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct colour swim hat, which will depend on the stage they are in. If you require a new hat please visit main reception or ask a member of the swim team and they will be able to give you the right hat for your stage. We really appreciate your support.

To further support the safeguarding and supervision of children on our Learn to Swim Programme, from the 9<sup>th</sup> February 2026 we are reintroducing a designated parent drop-off and collection point on poolside. You will see a clearly marked banner where parents will be asked to hand children over directly to the swim teachers at the start of lessons and collect them again from the same point at the end. Please ensure you are ready to collect your child at least 5 minutes before their lesson finishes. During lessons, we kindly ask parents to watch from the spectator area on poolside or café area only, **and not from the island in the middle of the pools.** Thank you for your cooperation and continued support.
